COBRO - Packaging Research Institute confirms based on delivered documents and tests executed by the Laboratory for Packaging Materials and Consumer Packaging Testing of COBRO, according to requirements of Commission Regulation (EU) No 10/2011, Annexes III and V (Test Report No DOJ-531-356/15), that thermal insulating EPS boxes, having composition as declared by the manufacturer, used in accordance with above mentioned purpose do not pose hazard to human health (positive organoleptic assessment; the overall migration far below the limit of 10 mg/dm²; specific migration of one substance subject to limitation far below its permissible limit; absent substances considered as dual use additives).

By means of this certificate COBRO confirms that thermal insulating EPS boxes, made according to requirements of Commission Regulation (EC) No 2023/2006 on good manufacturing practice for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food, meet the requirements of art. 3 of Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 October 2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food and also Commission Regulation (EU) No 10/2011 of 14 January 2011 on plastic materials and articles intended to come into contact with food (including its amendments Nos: 1282/2011, 1183/12, 202/2014 and 2015/174) and also the requirements of the Polish Parliamentary Act of 25 August 2006 on food and nutrition safety with subsequent amendments.
